Praying Against Giant Problems

Think about this passage (1 Pt. 5:6-7) and memorize verse 7

Read these passages and meditate on these truths. Then talk to God about it, especially as it relates to your problem

- God is "my" God

As a believer, I have a personal, intimate relationship with God. I belong to Him and I can claim Him as my God.

Read: Jn. 1:12; Gal. 4:4-7; 1 Pt. 2:9-10

- God's ears are open to hear my prayer

God will be quick to listen to me, His child. I know He will hear me whenever I pray to Him.

Read: 1 Pt. 3:12; 1 Jn. 5:14-15; Heb. 4:16

- God's eyes are open to see my situation

God sees and knows what I'm going through. He's paying attention and understands my situation and needs.

Read: Ps. 139:1-18; Mt. 6:25-33

- God is Jehovah Sabaoth (God of Hosts)

My heavenly Father has an army of angels and He is strong enough and powerful enough to protect me.

Read: Ps. 89:5-8; Jer. 32:27; Eph. 3:20-21; Isa. 40:28-31

- God is faithfully loving to me

My heavenly Father loves me and He will never stop loving me. I can depend on that love.

Read: Lam. 3:17-26; Ps. 103:8-17; Isa. 49:13-16
