- He comprehends our trouble *(2:25; Ps. 33:18)*

God Cares About His Children *(1 Pt. 5:7)*

Applying the Bible to Life

- What troubles are you currently experiencing in life? How do you mentally and emotionally process those troubles, most of the time? How helpful is prayer in your handling of those problems?
- Before you pray about that trouble, spend some time meditating on these biblical truths:
 - God actually does listen to you; even your groans.
 - God gets it. He understands what you're struggling with.
 - God won't forget His promises to you; including the promises that He'll be present with you and will help you.
